



Welcome to the Richmond Heights Preschool/Pre-k Program

We offer families quality early education while providing a happy and safe environment for children in which to flourish in early years. We believe that education is a three-way partnership between the child, parent and teacher. It is important that you feel involved in the education of your child.

Hours Monday-Thursday from 9:00 A.M. until 2:00 P.M.

The Preschool Program consists of two, all day classes. One of our classrooms is an integrated classroom which includes students with special needs and typically developing peer models ages three-five. Peer models provide peer interaction and model social skills for students with disabilities, while benefiting from the preschool experience. Peer models are an important component of the preschool program. The other classroom setting is a Pre-K classroom which includes students ages four-five.

Our programs here in Richmond Heights use Creative Curriculum. Creative Curriculum has lessons based on exploration and discovery as a way of learning, helping student's children to develop confidence, creativity and critical thinking skills. Creative Curriculum is aligned to the Early Learning Standards. It provides lessons and activities to help teachers so they can spend more time with students. Creative Curriculum also provides flexibility within the curriculum to meet the needs of the classroom and the students. Creative Curriculum provides books that connect to the studies within the curriculum. It provides resources to help teachers develop activities in literacy, math, interest areas, etc. Within each study, lessons are provided for large group, small group, interest areas, read aloud activities for motor development and Mighty Minutes which are great for transitions.
